4. Identity and distance to nearest gas gathering line: 1.5 miles.  
El Paso Natural Gas 1.5 miles Northwest.

5. Reason for and duration of exception desired:

The quantity of gas produced from the subject well is not sufficient to justify the  
cost of laying pipe to the nearest gas gathering line. A portion of the gas produced  
by this well is used on the lease as fuel for pumping units and heater treaters.  
Exception is requested for an indefinite period until economics will justify a connec-  
tion to the nearest pipeline.
