May 17, 1951: At 2:00 P. M., more than 72 hours after being cemented, the 5-1/2" 15-1/2# casing at 3345' was tested for water shut-off. Casing test made after bailing dry and allowed to stand 3 hours. No fluid entered. Cement plug drilled 3350' and bailed dry. Stood 3 hours for test and no fluid entered. Test considered satisfactory. Drilling ahead.
