## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Shot well with 70 Quarts Nitroglycerin from 3248' to 3294' with 28' of anchor on bottom and packed with 1 Yard Gravel. Shot went off at 4:30PM 8-28-43 went in hole with Tubing and found top of bridge at 3170' and cleaned out to bottom. Finished Cleaning out at 5AM August 31, 1943 and set 2" Tubing at 3271' with 2" EUE x 1 1/2" Swage Nipple on bottom of Tubing and pulled swab 2 times and well started flowing at 7:30PM 8-31-43, and well flowed until 10PM and shut in, made 148.60 Bbls Oil on open 2" Tubing.

September 1, 1943 took 24 hours test on 1/4" Choke made 145 Bbls Oil 2/10% BS&W  
Casing Pressure 600# Tubing 100# Volume 574,944 GOR 3966.
