Completed 8 3/4" Hole at 6AM August 18, 1943 and set 7" Casing at 3126' and cemented with 50 Sacks Incor and 200 Sacks Common at 7:30PM August 18, 1943, Plug at 3096'. August 22, 1943 at 2AM Tested Casing with 800# for 30 minutes before drilling plug and was OK. Drilling Plug at 5:30AM until 9AM August 22, 1943 on Bottom at 9:15AM circulated 1 hour and tested Casing with 800# for 30 Mins was OK.
