


# OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION SANTA FE, NEW MEXICO

Reports on minor operations need not be signed and sworn to before a notary public. See additional instructions in the Rules and Regulations of the Commission.

Completed 6 3/4" Hole at 9:30PM March 10, 1944, Circulated 2 hrs and layed down Drill Pipe and set 2" EUE Tubing at 3168' at 5PM March 11, 1944. Swabbed 3 hours and swabbed well in and took 6 hrs test on 1" Choke made 105.02 Barrels of Oil 1/10% BSEW. Killed Well and pulled Tubing and preparing to shoot with 170 Qts Nitroglycerin from 3160' to 3245'.
