We desire permission to shoot this well with approximately 140 quarts of nitro-glycerine from 3229' to 3299', tamping the shot with approximately 1 yard of gravel. The well produced 58 barrels of pipe line oil in 16 hours flowing through 2" tubing. Results of the shot will be reported after shooting and cleaning out to bottom.
