DETAILS OF WORK

It is our intention to drill a well at the above location with rotary tools to a total depth of approximately 3250'. All casing points will be cemented in accordance with approved methods of the U. S. Geological Survey and any other requirements will be complied with.

It is planned to use the following casing pattern: 7 5/8" casing to be set at approximately 1140' and cemented with approximately 435 sacks, cement to be circulated to surface. 5 1/2" casing to be set at approximately 3250' and cemented with approximately 500 sacks, or sufficient cement to return to the 7 5/8" casing seat.

Approval to produce this well upon completion is also requested.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
