DETAILS OF WORK

It is intended to drill a well at the above location with rotary tools to a depth of 3250' in the Yates and Seven Rivers formations. Casing will be set in accordance with USGS regulations and other special requirements will be complied with.

The following casing program is planned: 7-5/8" OD 24# H-40 csg to be set at 300' with 150 ax out, out to return to surface; 4-1/2" OD 9.5# J-55 csg to be set at 3250' with 175 ax out, out to return to 2500'.

Permission to produce this well upon completion is also requested.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
