FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK  
(FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS)

State "0" No. 2 was dually completed in the upper and lower Yates formation with a Baker Production Packer between the zones. The upper (gas) formation was not produced because the gas allowable was assigned to another well on the lease. The lower zone was a flowing oil well. However, the fluid production has changed to 98% water and the zone will no longer flow.

It is proposed to squeeze off the present perforations to shut off the water and re-perforate the Yates zone from 3148' to 3166' (18') and sand oil frac. It is believed that this work will reduce the water production and restore the well to producing status as an oil well.
