(1.) Cities Service Oil Co. is the owner and operator of the State "O" Lease consisting of 153.12 acres and is comprised of Ng of NWL, NWL of NEL and SEL of NWL of Section 32-268-37E, Les County, New Mexico. State "O" No. 2 is located 660' from the North line and 1980' from the East line of Section 32 and was completed August 29, 1958.

(2.) The initial potential on State "O" No. 2 was 190 barrels oil and 285 barrels water in 20 hours. Choke size was 24/64", FCP 300# and FTP was 1000# with a OOR of 1447 to 1. At the present daily allowable of 35 barrels of oil per day, the volume of gas to be flared will be approximately 50 MCF per day.
