## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

June 7, 1946, shot well from 6970 to 7170 with 680 qts. EL-357 and 120 qts. LNG. Tamped with 30' sand and 70' pea gravel. After cleaning out to bottom, swabbed well dry. June 24, 1946, acidized with 2000 gallons acid. Held 3000# to 3500# pressure 3-1/2 hours. Formation took estimated 1000 gallons acid. Well swabbed dry. June 28, 1946, acidized with 3000 gallons acid. Formation took 33 barrels of acid in 5 hours at 3100# to 3400# pressure. Well swabbed dry. August 22, 1946, circulated oil out of hole with water. Hole will be left in that condition until further notice.
