Oil Conservation Commission Administrative Order No. MC-1149 authorized dual completion of our H. V. Pike No. 1, Section 6-238-38E, Lea County, New Mexico, in the Blinbry Oil and Tubb Gas Pools.

In order to evaluate the Tubb zone, the well was perforated with two $\frac{1}{8}$ " JHPF in the following intervals: 6061-6063', 6097-6099', 6129-6131', 6140-6142', 6164-6166' and 6188-6190'. Following acid wash and gravel-oil fracture treatment, the Tubb zone flowed as follows on a 24 hour test ending March 3, 1962: 60 bopd, 13 bopd, 32/64" choke, tubing pressure 70#, 444 MCF gas per day, GOR 7,410, corrected gravity 36.0 degrees API.

Since a Tubb gas well could not be obtained, it is respectfully requested that permission be granted to dually complete subject well in the Blinbry Oil and Tubb Oil Pools. Commission Order No. R-1217 previously authorized Jai Oil Company (Now T P Coal and Oil Company) to dually complete the Sarkey No. 2, Section 25-21S-37E, Lea County, New Mexico, in the Blinbry Oil and Tubb Oil Pools.

By copy of this letter, all offset operators listed in the original application have been notified of the proposed change in the dual completion.
