DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Ran 80 joints 2887.22' of 9-5/8" OD 36# J-55 SS Casing. Set and cemented at 2899' w/1610 sacks cement, 1510 sacks 4% El Toro & Lone Star and 100 sacks Neat on bottom. Plug at 2828'. Maximum pressure 1000#. HOWCO temperature survey in 8 hours showed top cement behind 9-5/8" casing at 845' from rotary bushing.

After waiting over 30 hours tested 9-5/8" casing w/1000# pressure for 30 min. There was no drop in pressure. Drilled cement plug from 2826' to 2899'. Tested cement below casing shoe w/500# pressure for 30 minutes. There was no drop in pressure.

After approval of Mr. Yarbrough, State Oil and Gas Inspector, preparations were made to drill ahead.
