1. Moved in and rigged up workover rig March 21, 1971.
2. Ran tubing and bit and cleaned out fill from 6550' - 6875'.
3. Ran tubing and rods and equipped to pump. Tested.
4. Returned well to production status on March 25, 1971, producing 4 bbls. oil and 61 bbls. water from open-hole section 6450' - 6875' of the Tubb-Drinkard Reservoir.
