DETAILS OF WORK

This well is to be drilled to 11,500' for a test of the Ellenburger which is expected at 11,000'. The casing program on this well is to be as follows: Surface casing will be 13-3/8", H-40, 48# set at 450' with cement circulated to surface. Intermediate string will be 9-5/8" J-55 36# set at 4000'. Hole will be calipered to determine amount of cement required to circulate intermediate string. Oil string will consist of 10,200' 5 1/2" H-80 17#, and 1300' 5 1/2" H-80 20# to be set at 11,500' with 500 sacks cement.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
