DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

T. U. 3750' plugged back to 3520 with 63 sacks cement. Mudded hole with 150 sks mud from 3520' to 2560'. Set plug and cemented with 30 sks to 2500' mudded hole with 75 sks. Pulled 1150' of 8 5/8" casing. Set bridge at 1150' and dumped 44 sks cement fill up was to 1097' mudded w/80 sks. Set bridge at 720' used 34 sks cement, fill up to 683' - 7' in 10 3/4 casing which was not disturbed mudded hole to 20' of cellar and cemented w/10 sks. Regulation marker was placed. Location has been cleaned and restored as near as possible to original conditions.
