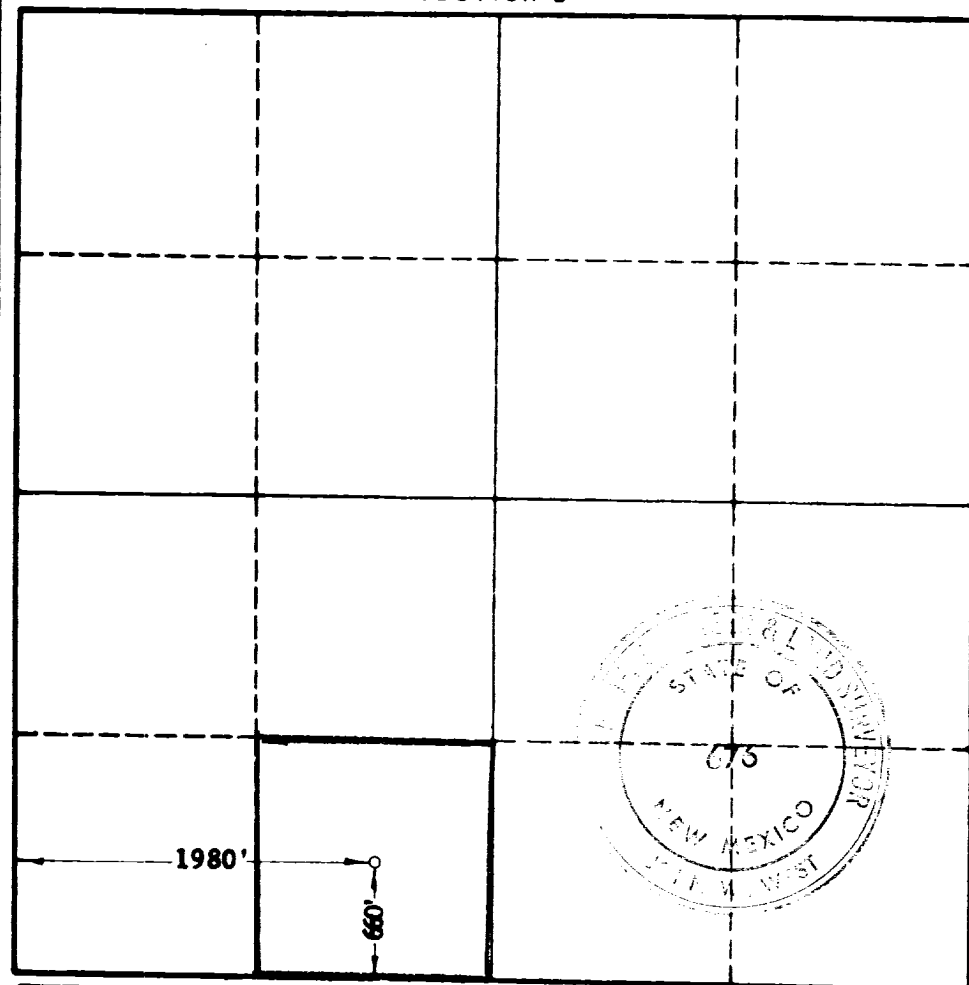

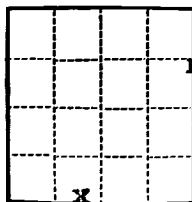

DETAILS OF WORK

(State names of and expected depths to objective sands; show sizes, weights, and lengths of proposed casings; indicate mudding jobs, cementing points, and all other important proposed work)

It is our intention to drill a well at the above location to an approximate depth of 5200', to attempt a completion in the Delaware horizon. All casing points will be cemented in accordance with approved methods of the USGS and any special requirements will be complied with.

It is planned to use following casing pattern: 11" hole, 7-5/8" casing to be set at 350' and cemented with 250 sacks cement. Cement is to circulate. 6-3/4" hole, 4-1/2" casing to be set at 5200' and cemented w/200 sacks cement. Cement is to return to 3900'.

Permission is requested to produce the well upon completion.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
