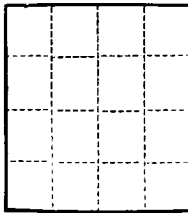

DETAILS OF WORK

Place cement plug from T.O. of 4602' to 50 ft above top of point where
 4 1/2" casing is cut off, cased at 4100' -
 Place 30 sacks cement plug at base of well at 4278', if necessary
 Place 30 sacks cement plug on top of salt at 1535'
 Place 30 sacks of cement across seat of surface pipe - 4-5/8" at 350'
 Place 30 sacks of cement on top of 4" pipe with 4" x 10' steel
 pipe marker 100' in depth and designating name No. of
 well and location.
 and laden fluid on top of each plug.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
