DETAILS OF WORK

Spudded 12 o'clock noon (MST), September 13, 1962.

Ran 902' of 20" (94#, R-40) casing and cemented to 912' with 1100 sacks Class "C" plus 8" gel and 400 sacks Class "A" plus 28 CaCl₂. Plug down at 10:45 p.m. (MST), September 19, 1962. Circulated approximately 450 sacks. After 12 hours, tested with 600 psi for 30 minutes - no drop in pressure.

1. 2870 cu.ft.
2. 1100 sxs Tenestar Incon; 83 sxs Flowgel; 400 sxs C.W. Port; 8 sxs CaCl₂.
3. 60°.
4. 70°.
5. 500 psi.
