DETAILS OF WORK

In accordance with Form 9-331a approved April 16, 1963, the following remedial work was performed. Squeezed perforations at 3193' with 100 sx slo-set cement. FBO 3170'. Perforated at 3146' in a single plane with 4 shots, acidized with 6500 Gal LSTNE. Tested from 4-13-63 to 5-7-63. Non commercial. Set retrievable bridge plug at 3125' and perforated 3080-81, 3094-95, 3096-97 W/2 SPF. Acidized with 1000 gallons. Tested from 5-7-63 to 5-20-63. Recovered load and 5 BO. Non commercial. Shut-in well for further evaluation.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
