DETAILS OF WORK

We propose to drill Hall-Federal no. 1 as a 14,250' Pennsylvanian test with rotary tools as follows:

Drill 26" hole to 1050' and cement 20" (94#) casing with 1000 sacks and circulate cement.

Drill 16" hole to 5400' and cement 13-3/8" (48#) casing with 2500 sacks and circulate cement.

Drill 12 1/2" hole to 12,200' and cement 9-5/8" (36#) casing with 2000 sacks and circulate cement.

Drill 8-5/8" hole to 14,250' and cement 7" (23#, 26#) casing with 600 sacks.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.

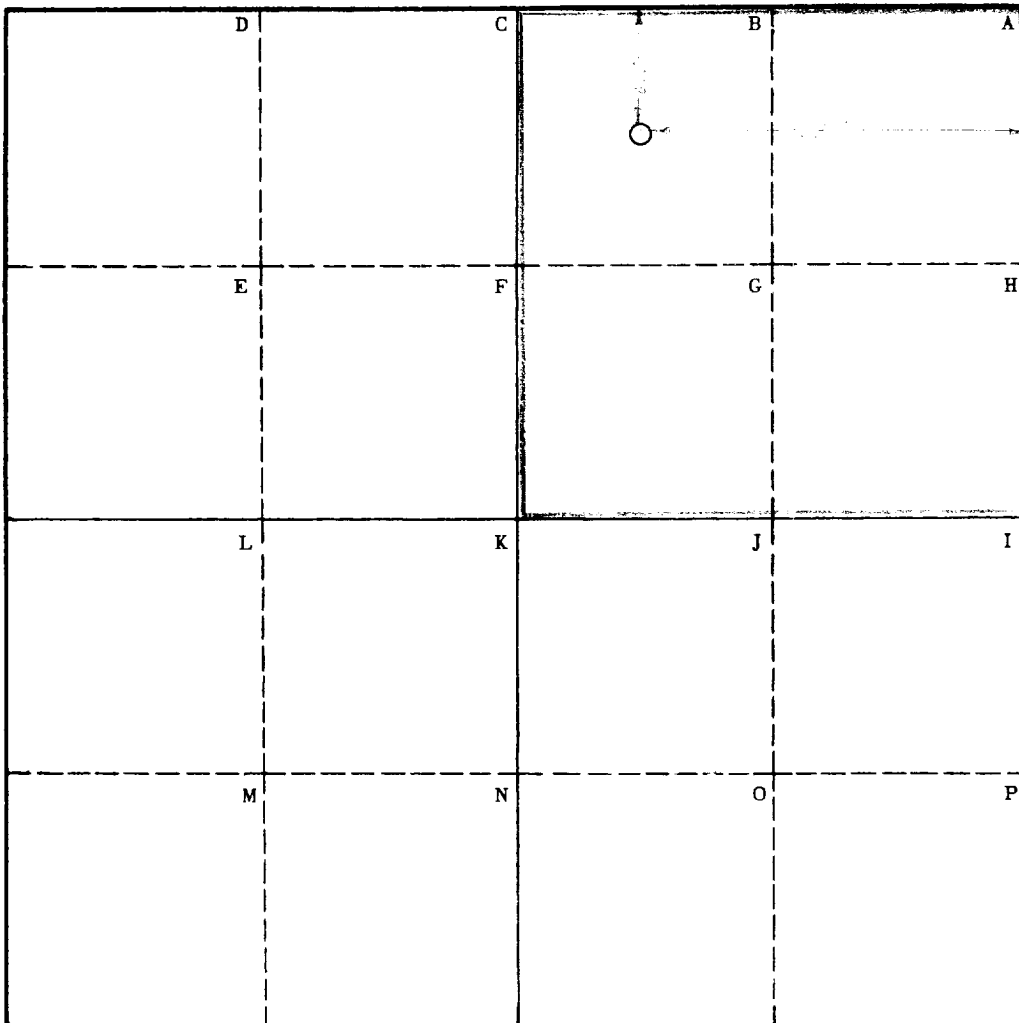
