3/22/69--Swabbed hole dry; showing some gas with trace of oil in acid water.

3/23/69--Fraced perfs with 10,000 gals. gelled water and 10,000 lb. of 20-40 mesh sand.

3/24/69--Ran rods and pump

3/24--4/3/69--ried to pump well but kept fouling w/sand. Ran reconditioned pump.

4/4--4/5/69--Well pumped in sl. w/50 lb.

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12/8/67 Pulled rods and tubing. Ran RTTS packer and squeezed perforations 3668'--78' w/ 50 sks. Max. press. 7000#. Reversed and washed to 3672'.

12/9/67 Perf. 2 holes each at 3669', 3634', 3635', 3631, and 3611'. Spotted 100 gal. 15% MCA on bottom. Broke down at 4100 psi. Acidized w/ 500 gals. MCA using 9 perf-pack balls. Swabbed to 3500'; only small amount of acid and acid gas feeding in.

12/10/67 Pulled tubing & RTTS packer. Fraced down casing with 15,000 gals. water w/ 15,000# 10-20 sand. Max. rate 34 BPM, Max. press. 3500# on sandout.

12/10-12/12/67 Cleaned out 100' sand, ran tubing and rods; well on production about 6:00 P.M. 12/12/67.

12/13/67 Gas lines frozen after 21 hrs. Est. rate 63 BOPD.
