The battery for the Ginsberg #13, #5 and #7 is located in Section 31, T25S, R38E, Unit Letter K, Lea County, New Mexico. Well # 5 and well #7 are normally producing every day out of each month. Well #13 is produced approximately one week out of each month. The production from well #13 is gauged by average production when only wells # 5 & #7 are producing and then a gauge is taken after 24 hrs when well #13 is put on production. This allows for monthly well testing to allocate production to well #13.

Chuza Operating became the operator of this lease effective 12-31-94. Fina Oil & Chemical Company was the prior operator.
