- 1) Moved in workover rig March 12, 1969. Pulled casing.
- 2) Ran 2-7/8"OD tubing with 6-1/4" bit.
- 3) Washed and cleaned out casings to old T.D. 1360' and started drilling new hole.
- 4) Drilled to 1600'.
- 5) Ran 50 Jts. (1600') of 4-1/2"OD 9.5# 8R SS R-2 J-55 "A" condition casing with RT&C and set at 1600'. Cemented with 450 sacks cement. Plug down 1:30 p.m. 3-22-69. Cement did not circulate. Cemented outside 4-1/2"OD casing to surface with 112 sacks cement.
- 6) Tested casing to 600'; held ok.
- 7) Perforated 4-1/2"OD casing as follows:

1516-1540' -	24'	-48 shots
1546-1552' -	6'	-12 shots
Total	30'	60 shots
- 8) Ran 48 Jts. (1479') of 2-3/8"OD tubing with Tension - Type packer set at 1482'.
- 9) Treated down tubing through perforations 1516-52' with 500 gallons 15% acid. Installed valve in tubing.
- 10) Converted to disposal well 3-24-69. Water will be injected into the Rustler Formation through 4-1/2"OD casing perforations 1516-1552'. This will be a salt water disposal well for our Mexico Fed "P" Well No. 1, which is in the process of being completed. Approved by New Mexico Oil Commission Order No. SWD-97 dated 2-25-69

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.

Item 17: Proposals to abandon a well and subsequent reports of abandonment should include such special information as is required by local Federal and/or State offices. In addition, such proposals and reports should include reasons for the abandonment; data on any former or present productive zones, or other zones with present significant fluid contents not sealed off by cement or otherwise; depths (top and bottom) and method of placement of cement plugs; mud or other material placed below, between and above plugs; amount, size, method of parting of any casing, liner or tubing pulled and the depth to top of any left in the hole; method of closing top of well; and date well site conditioned for final inspection looking to approval of the abandonment.
