Rigged up 5-1-69. Pulled rods, pump and tubing. Ran 5-1/2" HOC retriervable BP, set at 5459'. Displaced hole w/mod brine. Spotted 500 gals. 15% NEA & 1 ex sand on BP. Pulled tbq. Perforated 5327-29', 5380-82', 5426-28' w/G-70 Hyperjet 4 JHPF. Ran tbq, set at 5087'. Acidized w/3,000 gals 15% NEA w/1 - 1" ball sealer every 120 gals., flushed w/125 bbls mod brine. Avg. 1800 psi, AIR 7 BPM, ISIP 900#. Pulled tbq. Fraced down 5-1/2" cpg. in 3 stages of 1,000 gals. gelled pad, 6,000 gals w/1-1/2# 20/40 sand. 2nd & 3rd stages preceded w/8 - 1" ball sealers and 500 gals 15% NEA, flushed w/mod brine. Avg 3000 psi, AIR 34 BPM, ISIP 1200#. Retrieved BP, ran 2-3/8" tbq set at 5769'. Ran rods & pump returned well to production.

Well pumped 55 BO, 31 BW and 379 MCF gas in 24 hour test ending 5-15-69. GOR = 6890.

## Instructions

**General:** This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

**Item 4:** If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.

**Item 17:** Proposals to abandon a well and subsequent reports of abandonment should include such special information as is required by local Federal and/or State offices. In addition, such proposals and reports should include reasons for the abandonment; data on any former or present productive zones, or other zones with present significant fluid contents not sealed off by cement or otherwise; depths (top and bottom) and method of placement of cement plugs; and of other material placed below, between and above plugs; amount, size, method of parting of any casing, liner or tubing pulled and the depth to top of any left in the hole; method of closing top of well; and date well site conditioned for final inspection looking to approval of the abandonment.
