On 1-22-79 while pulling rods & pump, the rods were dropped. In attempting to recover the rods it was found the tubing had also parted. In attempting to fish the rods and tubing it was found that the 5½" casing had collapsed at a depth of 2978'. The casing was waged out to the top of the fish at 3034'. No further progress could be made and the well was shut-in 2-19-79 to evaluate alternatives.

On 4-20-79 fishing attempts were resumed. The 5½" casing was cut at 2988' and pulled. The 5½" casing was then washed over to 3210' and cut off with an outside cutter at 3201'. Several jts. of collapsed casing were recovered along with 8 rods. An impression block indicated bent over rods are extending about 50' above the 5½" casing stub at 3201'. Attempts to fish the rods were unsuccessful and on 5-12-79 the well was shut in to re-evaluate.
