Plan of Development - Rhodes Gas Storage Unit Numbers 12, 13, 14, 15, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, & 23.

- 1. Existing Roads The proposed wells are located in a well developed area that is well traversed with many existing roads. These roads are shown on the attached map. Repairs to existing roads will be made whenever necessary. (Existing roads in brown, state highways in black.)
- Planned Access Roads Approximately 14,000' of new access raods will be required for these locations. A 6" x 16' compacted caliche surface will be applied. (New road is noted on map in red.)
- 3. <u>Well Locations</u> Are indicated on map and application. All locations will be 120' x 200' x 6" compacted caliche.
- 4. Lateral Roads to Location None are planned.
- 5. <u>Tank Batteries & Flow Lines No tanks are planned</u>. Wells will be connected to gathering and repressuring system from nearest points practicable.
- 6. Locations and Type of Water Supply All water necessary for drilling will be hauled to location.
- 7. <u>Methods of Handling Waste Disposal</u> Regulation burn pits or other methods acceptable to U.S.G.S. and N.M.O.C.C. will be used.
- 8. Location of Camps None are planned.
- 9. Location of Airstrips None are planned.
- 10. Location Layout See enclosed plat.
- 11. <u>Restoration of Surface</u> Surface will be restored to a condition acceptable to U.S.G.S.
