Gentlemen:

On October 18, 1976, I completed my No. 1 Citgo "AS" State well as a gas producer from the Yates and Seven Rivers formations in the Jalmat Gas Pool. The subject well is located 660 FNL and 1980 FWL of Section 2, T-24-S, R-36-E, Lea County, New Mexico. Since the acreage to be dedicated to the subject well is less than the 640-acre spacing of the Jalmat Gas Pool, I am requesting that the NMOCC approve a non-standard gas proration unit for the subject well consisting of the NW/4 Section 2.

Three copies of a plat showing the location of my well and the outline of the proposed spacing unit are enclosed.
