
Your August 3rd letter refers to a conversation with your Garland, Texas operations office concerning the requirement of the plugging of the above-referenced well. First, I do not recall a conversation concerning the plugging of this well, since it is a "Federal" well plugging approval will come from the BLM office, not the Oil Conservation.

Our records show the Bettis well was to remain shut in and the acreage assigned to your Leonard Federal #13 in Unit L, Sec. 14, T26S, R376. Bettis could plug the well and the acreage could still be dedicated to your well through a communitization agreement.

If you desire to obtain an 80-acre gas proration unit for your Leonard Federal #13 (now Glenn-Ryan #17) you must make application to our Santa Fe office as required by Rule 104 D(2)
