

Multipoint Surface Use and Operations Plan

This plan is submitted with the Application for Permit to Drill the above described well. The purpose of the plan is to describe the location of the proposed well, the proposed construction activities and operations plan, the magnitude of necessary surface disturbances involved, and the procedures to be followed in rehabilitating the surface after completion of the operation so that a complete appraisal can be made of the environmental effects associated with the operation.

1. Existing Roads

- A. Existing roads in the vicinity of the planned well are shown on attached Exhibit A. The well is located approximately 8 miles SE of Eunice, New Mexico. To reach location, go due south from Eunice, New Mexico on State Highway 18 (Alternate) 6.1 miles. Continue SW on State 18 for approximately $\frac{1}{4}$ mile. Turn east on dirt county road for $2\frac{1}{4}$ miles; south for $\frac{1}{4}$ mile and then continue east for 2 more miles. Well is just south of main dirt road approximately $\frac{1}{8}$ mile. Route is marked in red from State 18 to location.

2. Planned Access Roads:

- A. No new roads will be required. Blading and watering of approximately $\frac{1}{2}$ mile of existing road will be required.
- B. Surfacing material will be six inches of caliche, water compacted and graded.
- C. Maximum grade will be 3 per cent.
- D. No turnouts, cattleguards, gates or culverts will be required.
- E. A three (3) feet cut will be necessary to level the location, dirt being moved from west to east.

3. Location of Existing Wells

- A. Existing wells within a one mile radius are shown on Exhibit "B".
