No inclination survey is required on wells that are drilled and completed as dry holes that are plugged and abandoned. Inclination surveys are required on re-entry of abandoned wells.) Inclination surveys must be made in accordance with the provisions of Statewide Rule

This report shall be filed in the District Office of the Commission for the district in which the well is drilled; by attaching one copy to each appropriate completion for the well. (except Plugging Report)

The Commission may require the submittal of original charts, graphs, or discs, resulting from the surveys.
