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- F. All trash and debris will be buried or removed from the well site after drilling and completion operations are completed. Pits will be levelled as soon as possible.

8. Auxillary Facilities

None required.

9. Well Site Layouts

- A. Exhibit "C" shows the relative location and dimensions of the well pad, mud pits, trash pit and location of major rig components. A 400' X 400' area was staked and flagged to insure flexibility in placing the well pad for the most feasible and environmentally acceptable manner. However, the well pad will only be approximately 200' X 200'.
- B. Only minor levelling of the well site will be required. No significant cuts or fills will be necessary.
- C. The reserve pit will be plastic lined.

10. Plans for Restoration of the Surface

- A. Subsequent to drilling and completion operations, all equipment and other materials not needed for operations will be removed. Pits will be filled and location cleaned of all trash and junk to leave the well site in as aesthetically pleasing a condition as is feasible.
- B. Any unguarded pits containing fluids will be fenced until they are filled.
- C. After abandonment of the well, any special rehabilitation requirements of the surface management agency will be complied with and accomplished as expeditiously as possible. All pits will be filled and levelled after abandonment.

11. Other Information

- A. Topography - Land surface is generally level with sand dunes.
- B. Soil - Fine to medium sandy loams.

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
