

SURFACE USE PLAN

Conoco Inc.
Lynn "A" No. 6

The plan is to accompany "Application for Permit to Drill" the subject well. The following is a discussion of pertinent information concerning possible effect which the proposed drilling of the well may have on the environment of the well and road sites and surrounding acreage. A copy will be posted on the derrick floor so that all contractors and sub-contractors will be aware of all items of this plan.

1. EXISTING ROADS

- A. The proposed well site is 1980' FNL and 2310' FWL, Section 28, T-23S, R36E, Lea County, New Mexico.
- B. Exhibit A is a portion of a New Mexico road map showing existing black-top roads. Directions to the location are as follows: From Conoco station in Eunice, go south on Loop 18 to Highway 18. Go 5 miles south on highway 18, then turn west on Teague switch graded road. Travel 4 miles west on Teague road, then go south 1.2 miles. Go 1 mile west to the Lynn A battery. From the battery, go 4 miles southwest, then north 1 mile. Finally go west 3 miles. Location is on the left side of the road.
- C, D, E. Access roads are shown on Exhibits B and C.
- F. No improvement or maintenance are anticipated for the existing roads.

2. PLANNED ACCESS ROADS

- A. Width and Length: New road required will be 12' wide and 320' long. This new road is labeled on Exhibits B and C.
- B. Turnouts: one.
- C. Drainage Design: New road will have a drop of 6" from center line on each side.
- D. Culverts, Cuts and Fills: 6' cut on all sides of location, no culverts are required.
- E. Surfacing Material: Six inches of caliche, bladed, watered and compacted.
- F. Gates, Cattleguards, Fences: None required.
- G. The proposed road is staked.
