

11. OTHER INFORMATION:

- A. Topography: The land surface in this area is gently sloping and undulating. Regionally, slope is to the southeast.
- B. Soil: Top soil at the well site is a loamy sand.
- C. Flora and Fauna: The vegetative cover is sparse and consists of mesquite, yucca, shinnery oak, sage, weeds and range grasses. Wildlife in the area is that typical of semi-arid desert land and includes coyotes, rabbits, rodents, reptiles, dove and quail.
- D. Ponds and Streams: There are no rivers, streams, lakes or ponds in the area.
- E. Residences and Other Structures: The nearest occupied dwelling, a ranch house, is approximately three and one-half miles southeast of the well site. The nearest windmill is approximately one and one-half miles southeast of the well site.
- F. Archaeological, Historical and Cultural Sites: None observed in the area.
- G. Land Use: Grazing and hunting in season.
- H. Surface Ownership: Federal.
