Re: Equitable Petroleum Corp. Exxon-Federal #1 Lea County, New Mexico Sample Description

- 4436-38 Anhydrite-blk shale (Sdy)-Red sand ect (Caving's) trace Gray shy sd.
- 4438-40 Sd: gray dk gray, sl friable, argillaceos, faint odor, fair taste, spotted to sploched, pale yellow fluorescence.
- 4440-42 Sd:lt. gry-white, very fine, soft, friable, sl. shy. calcarious, faint odor, good fluorescence, pale blue white, light cut.
- 4442-44 Sd: Lt. gry-tan, vf to fine grain, soft, friable, Sc tr argillaceous inclusions, tr vf pink feldspar, calcarious cemt. very faint odor, good blue-white fluorescence, light cut.
- NOTE: Pumped abundant cement (hard) red beds, anhydrite red sd - blk sdy sh. for several hours before hole started cleaning up.
