

AMENDED ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER SWD-549

APPLICATION OF ENRON OIL & GAS COMPANY FOR SALT WATER DISPOSAL,  
LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO.

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER  
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION DIVISION

Under the provisions of Rule 701(B), Enron Oil & Gas Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division on November 22, 1993, for permission to complete for salt water disposal its Vaca Ridge "30" Federal Com No.1 located 1980 feet from the South line and 1980 feet from the West line in Unit K of Section 30, Township 24 South, Range 34 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

THE DIVISION DIRECTOR FINDS THAT:

- (1) The application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 701(B) of the Division Rules and Regulations.
- (2) Satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators and surface owners have been duly notified; and
- (3) The applicant has presented satisfactory evidence that all requirements prescribed in Rule 701 will be met.
- (4) No objections have been received within the waiting period prescribed by said rule.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

(1) The applicant herein, Enron Oil & Gas Company is hereby authorized to complete its Vaca Ridge "30" Federal Com No.1 located 1980 feet from the South line and 1980 feet from the West line in Unit K of Section 30, Township 24 South, Range 34 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the injection of salt water for disposal purposes into the Bell Canyon formation at approximately 5424 feet to approximately 6400 feet through 2 7/8 inch plastic lined tubing set in a packer located at approximately 5324 feet
