1. Set cement retainer @ 20,500'. Squeezed Fusselman perms w/ 175 sx LS Premium cement. Squeezed to 3,000 psig. Reversed out 15 sx.

2. Perforated Fusselman from 20,418' to 20,458'. Tested same.

\* 3. Set B.P. @ 18,311'. Dumped 36' cement on top of B.P. PBTD now 18,275'.

4. Ran Schlumberger CBL/GR/CLC log from 18,000' to 14,400'. Set Baker Model -DB- pkr @ 15,200'. Perf Atoka from 15,356' to 15,372'. Broke down perms w/ 4,000 gal treated wtr & 5,000 gals N-Ver-Sperse-O treating fluid. Tested zone.

5. Set two plugs in pkr. Dumped 26' of sand on top of pkr. PBTD 15,174'. Set Baker Model -DB- pkr @ 14,462'. Perf Strawn from 14,674' to 14,696'. Now evaluating same.
