- 1. EXISTING ROADS Area map, Exhibit "A" is a reproduction of the Woodly Flat and Bell Lake, New Mexico U.S.G.S. 7.5' quadrangle. Existing roads are shown in this map.
 - A. Exhibit "A" shows the prepared location as staked.
 - B. From Jal, New Mexico go west 21 miles on N.M. State Highway 128 to a cattleguard in the south R.O.W. line of the highway. Travel south and east on a caliche lease road 5.6 miles to a flagged reference stake 200' east of the proposed well bore.
 - C. The existing described road route is shown on Exhibit "A".
- 2. PLANNED ACCESS ROAD As shown on Exhibit "A", 50' of new access road will be constructed.
 - A. The cleared width of the road will be 25'. The road surface will be 14'.
 - B. No grades will be present on the new road.
