APPLICATION OF SOUTHWEST ROYALTIES, INC. TO EXPAND ITS PRESSURE MAINTENANCE PROJECT IN THE SCARBOROUGH YATES-SEVEN RIVERS POOL IN LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO

## ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER OF THE OIL CONSERVATION DIVISION

Under the provisions of Division Order No. R-6277, Southwest Royalties, Inc. has made application to the Division on September 8, 1997 for permission to expand its Scarborough Yates- Seven Rivers Pressure Maintenance Project in the Scarborough Yates-Seven Rivers Pool in Lea County, New Mexico.

## THE DIVISION DIRECTOR FINDS THAT:

- (1) The application has been filed in due form.
- (2) Satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators have been duly notified of the application.
- (3) No objection has been received within the waiting period as prescribed by Rule 701(B).
- (4) The proposed injection well is eligible for conversion to injection under the terms of Rule 701.
- (5) The proposed expansion of the above referenced pressure maintenance project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
  - (6) The application should be approved.

## IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

The applicant, Southwest Royalties, Inc., be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Seven Rivers and Yates formations at approximately 2902 feet to approximately 3450 feet through 3 1/2-inch plastic lined tubing set in a packer located at approximately 2850 feet in the following described well for purposes of pressure maintenance to wit:
