

4)MIRU perforators. Perforate the Yates 2 JSPF, 22-.45" holes, 4" casing gun over the following intervals 3159'- 3170'(new perfs) total perfs (3159'-3230'). Set RBP @ 3250' & Packer @ 3190', Dowell acidized lower Yates perfs 3208'-3230' w/1500 gas 15% NEFE. Shut-in due to storm 6-26-96.  
5)Reset RBP @ 3190' & PKR @ 3098'. Dowell acidized Upper Yates perfs 3159'-3170' w/3000 gals 15% NEFE. Release PKR & RBP & POH. 6-27-96  
6)TIH w/ tubing/anchor/GA. SET SN AT 3300'. RIH w/ rods and pump. RD 6-28-96.  
7)Put on test 6-29-96 thru 7-16-96.  
8)OPT 14 bo, 57 bw, 2 mcf.
