ORDER OF THE DIVISION

THE DIVISION:

This cause came on for hearing at 8:15 a.m. on July 29, 1993 at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner Michael E. Stogner.

NOW, on this 30th day of August, 1993 the Division Director, having considered testimony, the record and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised of the premises,

FINDS THAT:

- (1) Due public notice having been given as required by law, the Division has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) The applicant, Hal J. Rasmussen Operating, Inc., seeks approval for four orthodox oil well locations all in Township 26 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Scarborough Seven Rivers Pool, Lea County, New Mexico:

- Eaves "A" Well No. 18
160 feet from the North line and 2173 feet from the East line, Unit B of Section 30;
- Eaves "A" Well No. 19
1414 feet from the South line and 3190 feet from the East line (approximately 2108' FWL), Unit K of Section 19;
