SUBJECT: Division Order R-5353-P

Dear Mr. LeMay:

According to the provisions of Division Order R-5353-P, effective October 1, 1994, the following pool is created in Lea County, New Mexico:

✓ NORTH TEAGUE-TUBB ASSOCIATED POOL
Pool Code: 96315

The pool is created with special rules, which include the following:

- 1> A standard oil proration unit consists of 40 acres.
- 2> The top allowable for a standard oil proration unit is 142 barrels of oil per day.
- 3> A standard gas proration unit consists of 160 acres.
- 4> A limiting GOR of 6,000 cubic feet of gas per barrel of oil.

The Texaco Exploration & Production Inc. B. F. Harrison B Well No. 25 located in Unit C of Section 9, Township 23 South, Range 37 East, originally classified as producing from the Teague-Tubb Pool, is reclassified as producing from this newly created pool.
