Reference is made to your recent application for an exception to Rule 303 / The Unvision Rules and Regulations to permut the subject well to commingle production trace both pools in the wellbore.

It appearing that the subject well qualifies for approval for such exception cursuant to the provisions of Rule $303 \ll$ and that reservoir damage or waste will not result from such downhole commingling, and correlative rights will not be violated thereby, you are nereby authorized to commingle the production as described above and any Division Order which authorized the dual completion and required separation of the two zones is hereby placed in theyance.

In accordance with the provisions of Rule 303-C-4., total commingled the production from the subject well shall not exceed 40 barrels per day, and total water production shall not exceed 80 barrels per day. The maximum amount of gas which may be produced dates from the well shall be determined by multiplying 2000 by the top unit allowable for the South Teague Abo Pool.

In accordance with the growsions of Rule 303-C, the supervisor of the Heppe District Office of the Oil Conservation Division shall determine the proper allocation of promotion from the subject well following its completion.

FURTHER: The operator shall notify the Hobbs District Office the Division upon implementation of the commingling process.

Pursuant to Rule 303-3 in the commingling authority granted by the organized by the Division Director of in his opinion, conservation is not being best derved by such commingling.
