6. PLANS FOR RESTORATION OF THE SURFACE:

- (A) After the completion of the drilling and completion operations, all equipment and other material not needed for production operations will be removed. The location will be cleaned of all trash and junk to leave the well in an aesthetically pleasing condition as possible.
- (B) Any unguarded pits containing fluid will be fenced until they are dry and back filled.
- (C) After abandonment of the well, the surface restoration will be in accordance with the current federal laws and regulations. The location will be cleaned, and the well pad ripped or removed to promote vegetation and the disposal of all human waste will be complied with. Trash, waste paper, garbage, and junk will be hauled to an approved disposal site in an enclosed trash trailer.
- (D) All trash and debris will be removed from the well site within 30 days after finishing drilling and completion operations.

7. ANCILLARY FACILITIES:

No airstrip, campsite, or other facilities will be necessary.

8. WELL SITE LAYOUT:

Exhibit #4 shows the relative location and dimensions of the well pad.

9. SURFACE OWNERSHIP:

The well site is located on private surface. Energen Resources Corporation has entered into an agreement with the surface owner, Deep Wells Ranch, Inc. of Jal, New Mexico, regarding the drilling of the well and the access road.
