



DETAILS OF WORK

TD - 4718'
4 1/2" casing cemented at 4718', top of cement 4140'.

Two drill collars were stuck in 4 1/2" O.D. casing at approximately 4447'. Unable to recover drill collars because of junk. Plans made to cut off 4 1/2" O.D. casing at approximately 4100', recover same, and spot approximately 150' cement plug from 3950' to 4100'. Run retrievable whipstock to side track existing 6 3/4" hole at approximately 3950'. Drill 6 3/4" hole to total depth, approximately 4650'. Run new string of 4 1/2" O.D. casing to 4650', and cement with 150 sx regular.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
