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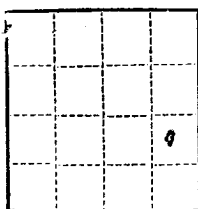

DETAILS OF WORK

(State names of and expected depths to objective sands; show sizes, weights, and lengths of proposed casings; indicate mudding jobs, cementing points, and all other important proposed work)

We propose to drill a well using rotary tools to approximately 4650' to produce the Delaware Sand. 8-5/8" casing will be set at approximately 800' or into the anhydrite, circulating cement to surface. 5-1/2" casing will be set to bottom using 200 sacks of cement. Gamma-Ray Neutron log will be taken. We propose to core bottom portion to establish horizons. Sand frac will be used to induce production. State and Federal laws will be complied with. Permission to produce upon completion is requested.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
