DETAILS OF WORK

We propose to drill a well, using rotary tools to approximately 4950' for production of the Delaware Sand. The proposed casing and cementing program is to set 8-5/8" casing in the top of the Anhydrite, circulating cement to the surface at approximately 1100' and drilling 12-1/4" hole. To set 5-1/2" casing to bottom, cementing with 200 sacks cement and to perforate using Gamma Ray-Nuetron for guidance. To core bottom of hole to establish production horizon. To conform to State and Federal Regulations. Permission to produce on completion is herewith requested.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
