This is to advise that on January 4, 1952, we ran 374.11' (14 joints) of new and used 13-3/8" OD 48# 8rd thrd seamless casing to total depth 362' (pipe was 12' above floor when landed at total depth) and cemented with 140 sacks of cement preceded with 15 barrels of water. Cement circulated when plug was 35' off shoe. Pumped plug to 347'.

On January 8, 1952, after standing cemented 60 hours, plug was drilled and water shut-off tested by the bailing method. Shut off tested satisfactory and drilling operations were continued.

Halliburton Oil Well Cementing Company equipment was used in cementing operations.
