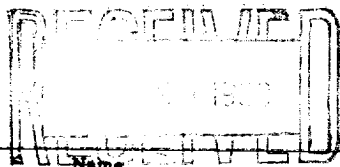

**DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED**

**Production before installing flow valves:** 50 Bbls. Oil & 6400 Bbls. Water in 24 hrs. flowing thru 3" tubing with 800# outside gas on casing; and using 1,300,000 cu.ft. daily for flowing.

**Production after installing flow valves:** 45 Bbls. Oil & 8400 Bbls. Water in 24 hrs. flowing thru casing with 900# outside gas on tubing. Using average of 775,000 cu.ft. flowing gas daily.
