On April 14, 1949, Mr. Yarbrough approved Form C-101, Notice of Intention to Drill, on your Jal #1 Well. To this date no additional reports have been filed.

My Scout Report reflects that this well was spudded on April 14, 1949. The Scout Report also reflects that 9 5/8" casing was set at 1163' and that the well was drilled to a total depth of 3435'. Therefore I am sure you must have also set the 7" casing. The only record we now have of the well is the Scout Report which shows the well as Dry and Abandoned on May 2, 1949.

Will you please file your drilling reports on this well along with the Well Record, Form C-105, and advise if this well is Plugged and Abandoned or Temporarily Abandoned.
